- ESFA Adult education budget (AEB) funding rules 2021 to 2022:

- ESFA Update FE Workforce Data Collection: The data submission will be mandatory from 2021-22: FE Data Collection
- EU Settlement Scheme Deadline Approaching: With the EU Settlement Scheme (EUSS) application deadline now less than 50 days away, the Home Office would appreciate your continued support in reminding parents, families, young people and staff that if they are an EU, EEA or Swiss citizen, they and their family members may be eligible to apply to the Settlement Scheme.
